SUMMARY (Second Quarter of 2016)


- The number of international arrivals in Georgia increased by +11.8%, compared to the same period in 2015.
- The majority of foreign travelers (84%) were from neighboring countries.
- The highest share of international travelers (82%) visited Georgia by land.
- There are approximately 1,562 accommodation units, with a total capacity of 53,604 beds registered in the GNTA database.



INTERNATIONAL ARRIVALS (Second Quarter of 2016)

- A record 1,504,993 international travelers arrived in Georgia, representing a +11.8% increase over the same period in 2015. Furthermore, data of six months showed 2,641,699 international arrivals in Georgia, with +13.1% growth rate.
- The highest number of arrivals, 523,091, was registered in May.
- According to Georgian border crossing statistics of the total number of visits lasted longer than 24 hours is increased by +20%, same day visitors by +11.5% and transit decreased by -0.2%.

¹International visitors' survey conducted by Georgian National Tourism Administration showed the share of tourists from total number of international visitors to be 61%. According to UNWTO "Tourist is a visitor taking an overnight trip to a main destination outside his/her usual environment, for less than a year, for any purpose (business, leisure or personal) other than to be employed by a resident entity in the country or place visited".

IMPORTANT TENDENCIES (Second Quarter of 2016)

- The majority of foreign travelers (84%) were from neighboring countries. Turkey took a dominant position among them with 356,993 (+4%) international arrivals.
- A notable increase in arrivals were registered from Azerbaijan (+35,893; +12.1%), Russia (+33,406; +15.2%) and Iran (+16,417; +369.5%). Likely due to the new visa policy with Iran. Marketing campaigns administered by the Georgian National Tourism Administration also played a significant role.
- A notable increase was registered from Israel (+14,196, +97.9%,), due to a direct flights and a marketing campaign administered by GNTA.
- International arrivals from the European Union amounted to 70,446, representing a 5% share of total arrivals.

First Six Month of 2016 Year Statistical Data:

- The largest number of international arrivals 686,575 was registered from Azerbaijan.
- A significant increase in arrivals was registered from Iran 707,85 (+400.6%), caused by the introduction new visa policy.
- The number of foreign travelers from neighboring countries reached 2,268,713 representing 86% of total arrivals.
- International arrivals from the European Union countries amounted to 104,139, representing a 4 % share of total arrivals.



INTERNATIONAL ARRIVALS BY BORDERS (Second Quarter of 2016)

- The largest share of visitors, 82% (1,231,390) arrived in Georgia by land transport, followed by air transport, 251,654.
- In Addition, during the first six months, 2,203,726 travelers arrived in Georgia by land, followed by air transport travelers 396,972.
- The busiest border crossing was Sarpi (Turkish border), which saw 345,708 crossings. The same border registered 609,065 international arrivals during the six month period.


ACCOMMODATION SECTOR (Second Quarter of 2016)

- The capital of Georgia, Tbilisi dominates the Georgian hotel market with the largest share (26%) of total number of beds.


Distribution of Accommodation Units
