MRG Overview

- Ltd "Mountain Resorts Development Company" (MRG) was established in 2013
- MRG is a subordinated entity of the Ministry of Economy and Sustainable Development of Georgia
- Under the management of MRG are all Georgian mountain ski resorts – **Gudauri**, **Bakuriani** (Didveli, Kokhta-Mitarbi), **Mestia** (Hatsvali, Tetnuldi) and **Goderdzi**
- Three mountain ski resorts were added to the Georgian winter resorts for the past 3 years:
 - Goderdzi - December 2015
 - Tetnuldi - February 2016
 - Kokhta-Mitarbi - 2015/2016



Implemented Projects

- Development of Kobi-Gudauri Master Plan
- Construction of 12 ski-lifts in Tetnuldi, Bakuriani and Gudauri
- Installation of Mestia-Hatsvali ski-lift
- Construction of 2 ski lifts in Goderdzi
- Construction of 5 ski lifts in Svaneti villages
- Establishment of Adventure Tourism School in Gudauri
- Creation of bike park and bike routs
- Construction of alpine coaster (toboggan) in Bakuriani
- Planning and designing biathlon infrastructure
- Installation of artificial snowmaking system
- Formation of ski patrol
- Training for the personnel of snow grooming machines, rescue team and cableway installations
- Realisation of training program for the mountain managers

Future Projects

- Elaboration of Mountain Tourism Development Strategy
- Construction of Mulakhi-Tetnaldi ski lift
- Renovation of 3 ski lifts in Gudauri
- Construction of Olympic standards biathlon and ski jump infrastructure
- Construction of ice hokey infrastructure
- Installation of artificial snow making system and artificial reservoir in Bakuriani
- Construction of meteorological stations in Bakuriani, Goderdzi, Gudauri and Mestia

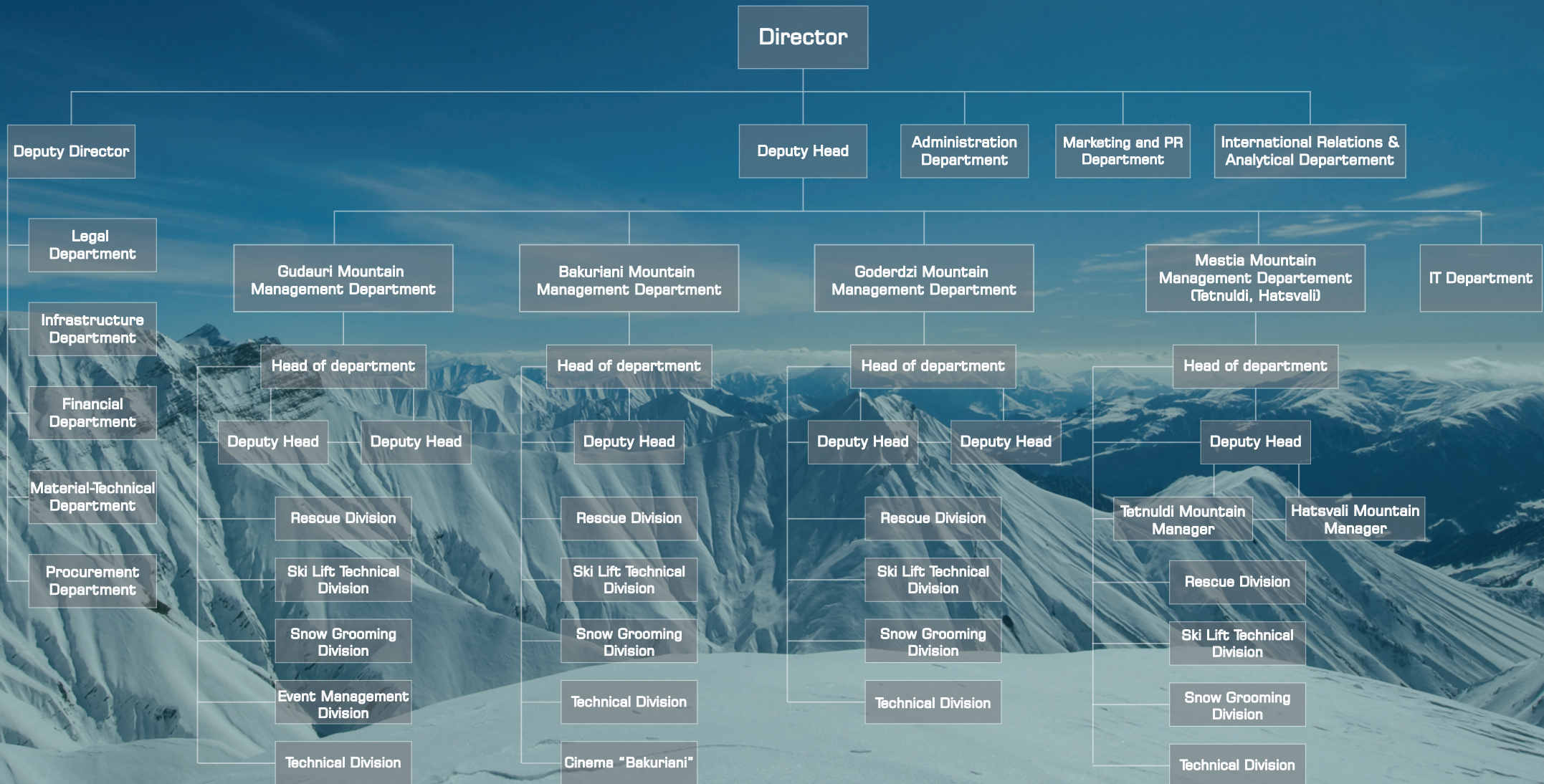
Goderdzi

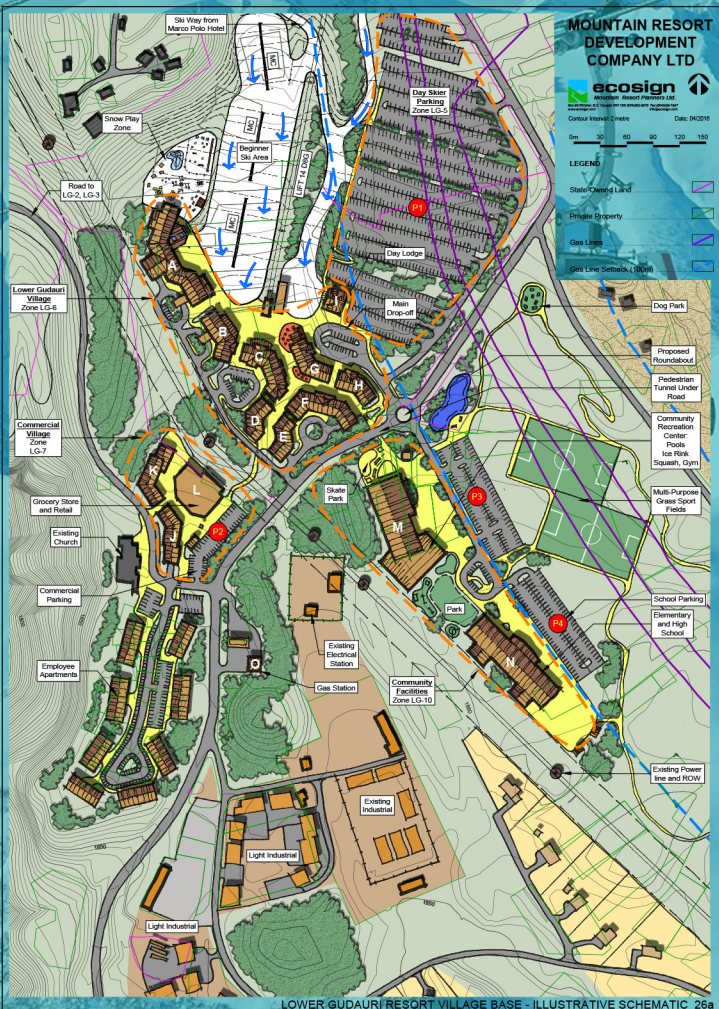
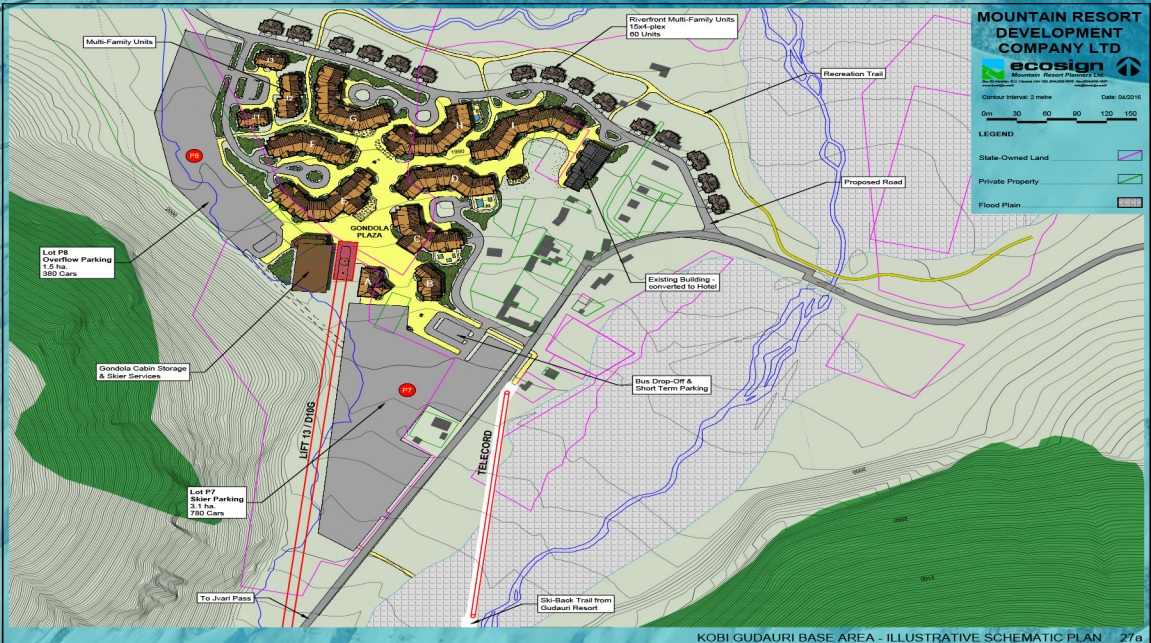


Ski Resort Management Chart

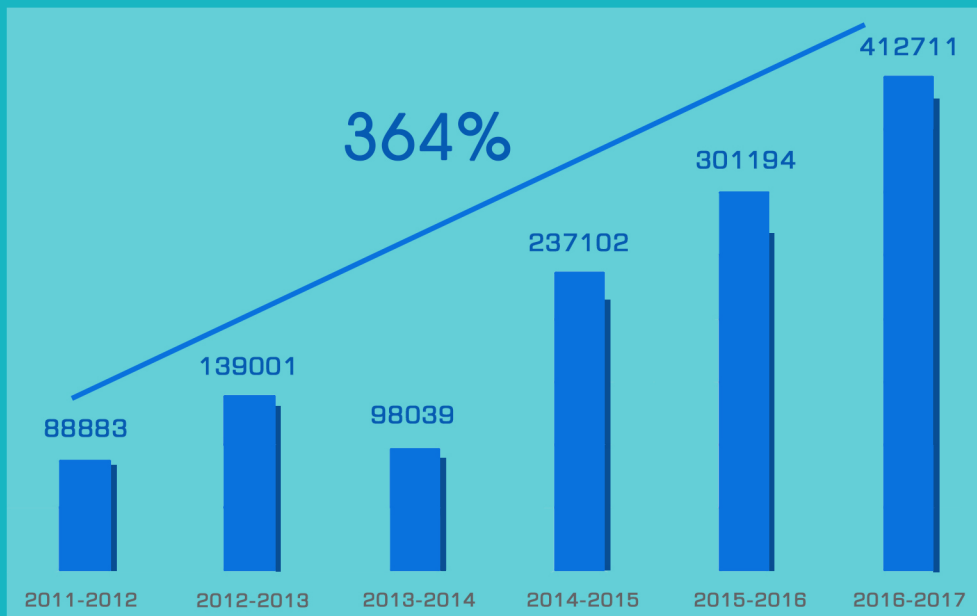

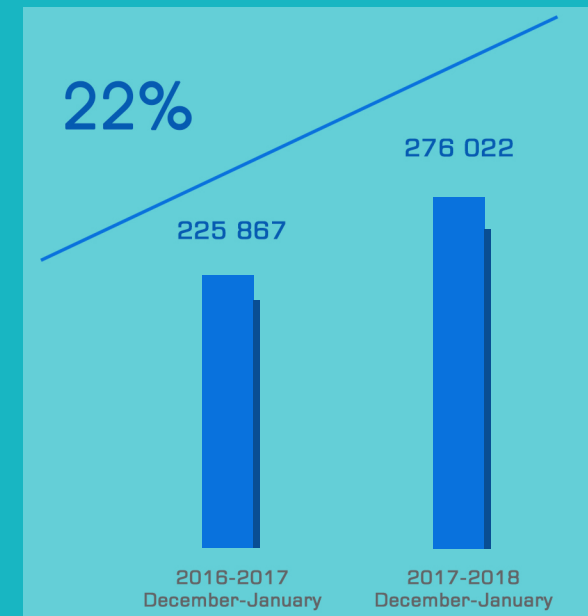
Mountain Ski Resorts Visitors Overview

Georgian tourist destinations have booming number of both local and regional visitors. Annually, according to the statistical data of Skidata (2010-2017) access system, the number of visitors increases sharply compared to the past years. If we take 2010-2011 winter season as a base year, since then total winter season visits have increased 364%.
